- Section B BRC Riding Test (Prelim level) You ride the Prelim test shown but it is judged on the rider. Marks are awarded for, Position, Effective use of aids, Influence of the rider, Accuracy and Harmony between the pair.

Restricted - combinations with no more than 20 BD points at Novice

Class 5 Novice 24 (2010)

Restricted - combinations with no more than 20 BD points at Elementary
