Class 1: Pure, Part Bred & Anglo Arab Ridden Stallion, Mare or Gelding.

All animals to be registered. Riders any age. see rules for Ridden Stallions classes may be split into height sections. Pure Breds may have their own class.

Class 2 - Hacks & Riding Horse Ridden Mare or Gelding.

Hacks not to exceed 160cms. Riding Horses exceeding 148cms. Riders to have attained their 15th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Classes may be split between Hacks & Riding Horses

Class 3 - Show Cobs Ridden Mare or Gelding.

Exceeding 148cms. Riders to have attained their 15th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Classes may be split between Lightweight, Heavyweight & Maxi.

Class 4 - Traditional Cobs Ridden Stallion, Mare or Gelding.

Riders any age. See rules for Ridden Stallions

Class 5 - Coloured Horse/Pony Ridden

To include SKEWBALD, PIEBALD, APPALOOSA, SPOTTED, PALOMINO & DUN. Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Riders any age. see rules for Ridden Stallions Classes may be split into Colour Type

Class 6 - Hunters Ridden Mare or Gelding.

Exceeding 148cms. Riders to have attained their 16th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 7 - Mountain & Moorland Part Bred Ridden Stallion, Mare or Gelding.

All M&M Part breeds must be registered. Riders any age. see rules for ridden Stallions) classes may be split into height

Class 8 - Show/Riding Pony Ridden Mare or Gelding.

Not to exceed 148cms. Classes may be divided as follows: - n/e 128cms, ex 128cms - n/e 138cms, ex 138cms - n/e 148cms Riders to be suitable size for cony ridden.

Class 9 - Show Hunter Pony Ridden Mare or Gelding.

Not to exceed 153cms. Classes may be divided as follows: - n/e 122cms, ex 122cms - n/e 133cms, ex 133cms - n/e 143cms, ex 143cms - n/e 153cms Riders to be suitable size for pony ridden

Class 10 - Mountain & Moorland Ridden Stallion, Mare or Gelding.

To be registered with their respective Pure Breed Society Stud Books. Riders any age. see rules for Ridden Stallions) Classes may be split into sections.

Class 11 - Competition Horse/Pony Ridden Competition Type Horse/Pony. Stallion, Mare or Gelding.

(excluding Mountain & Moorland) Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) Judged 60% Performance to include Freestyle Show, and 40% Conformation. Classes may be split into not exceeding 148cms and exceeding 148cms.

Class 12 - Veteran Horse/Pony Ridden Horse or Pony.

Fifteen years old and over. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) Classes may be split into 15 - 25 years and 25 and over

Class 13 - Ex-Racehorse Ridden Horse or Pony. Four years old and over.

Class 14 - Heavy horse or part bred heavy horse - Four years old and over.

All Equines in this section MUST be registered. Classes may be split into ages and or height. Pure Breds may have their

Class 16 - Hacks & Riding Horse In-Hand

Hacks not to exceed 160cms. Riding Horses to exceed 148cms. Classes may be split into ages and or height sections

Class 17 - Traditional Cob Type In-Hand Stallion, Mare or Gelding, Any Height.

Class 18 - Coloured Horse/Pony In-Hand

To include SKEWBALD, PIEBALD, APPALOOSA, SPOTTED, PALOMINO and DUN. Classes may be split into ages and or Colour Type.

Class 19 - Hunters In-Hand

To exceed 148cms. Classes may be split into ages

Class 20 - Mountain & Moorland Part Bred In-Hand

All Part Breds must be registered. Classes may be split into ages and or height.

Class 21 - Mountain & Moorland In-Hand

Ponies must be registered with their respective Pure Breed Society Stud Books. Classes may split into Ages & or Breeds.

Class 22 - Show/Riding Pony In-Hand

Not to exceed 148cms. Classes may be split into age and or height sections.

Class 23 - Show Hunter Pony In-Hand Not to exceed 153cms.

Classes may be split into age sections

Class 24 - Owner Bred In-Hand Mountain & Moorland

Ponies must be registered with their respective Pure Breed Society Stud Books. Classes may split into Ages and or Breeds. Open Type (excluding M&M): Horse or Pony. Any Age. Classes may be split into Height, Type or Age.

Class 25 - Competition Horse/Pony In-Hand

Competition Type Horse/Pony Classes may be split into n/e 148cms & ex 148cms, or into Young-stock & Four and over.

Class 26 - Driving Type Horse/Pony In-Hand

Driving Type Horse/ Pony Classes may be split into n/e 148cms and ex 148cms, or into Young-stock and Four and over

Class 27 - Veteran Horse/Pony In-Hand

Horse or Pony. 15 years old and over. Classes may be split into 15 - 25 years and 25 and over.

Class 28 - World Breeds inc. Moorland & Hill Bred In-Hand

Horse or Pony. (Excluding British Native Breeds, M&M Part Breeds, Pure, Part Bred & Anglo Arabs) Any Age. Classes may be split into Young-stock & Adult Stock

Class 29 - Ex Racehorse In-Hand Horse or Pony. Four years old and over.

Class 30 - Miniature Horse / Pony In-Hand Miniature Horse, registered with their respective Miniature Horse Society. May be split into Young-stock & Adult Stock. Miniature Shetland, registered with the Shetland Pony Society Stud Book. May be split into Young-stock & Adult Stock

Class 31 - Heavy Horse or Part bred Heavy Horse –

May be split into Young-stock & Adult Stock.
