Time Allowed

• In Advanced Medium, Medium, Elementary and Pairs Dressage to Music the time allowed is 4½ to 5 minutes. In Novice and Prelim Dressage to Music the time allowed is 4 to 5 minutes.

- All DTM tests are timed from the first halt to the final halt. The Music
- The music must be recorded on a standard CD. The CDs must be labelled as follows:

• Rider's name and competitor number, Horse/pony's name, Club must be on the CD & Rider's name and competitor number must be shown on the CD Container

• Indication of when to start the music (i.e., start music as I salute or start music as I reach D)

• The CD must only contain the entire compilation of music that is to be played for that specific test. Please provide 2 CD's. If the music fails in the beginning, the rider will be stopped, and the backup disc will be used. If the music fails at any other time, the rider must keep going unless the judge at C signals for the rider to stop.

• It is very important that a definite signal to start is given.

• CD's must be handed to the secretary at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time of their test. Competitors may provide their own technical adviser to be present in the commentator's box to supervise the playing of the CD. It is recommended that they have a duplicate CD readily available.

• No more than 20 seconds of introductory music may be played before the entry at A

Number of Entries

A horse may not ride the same dressage test with the same judge more than once per day or be ridden competitively by more than two people per day or have more than four ridden efforts per day.

All competitors in DTM competitions must be current club members of BD unless in a pair where only one person needs to be a club member. Competitors will then need to fill out the relevant licence form and return to BD. This allows you to use any music from the record labels listed on the Phonographic Performance Ltd (PPL) repertoire list. tracks not listed cannot be used. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they hold the relevant licence and PPL stickers before competing. The test executed at the Championships, along with the music used should fundamentally be the same as that which was ridden at the qualifier.
